

DIRECTIONS: WALKING / BY CAR / AND PARKING FACILITIES

St George's Centre and St George's Church are situated next door to Leeds General Infirmary on Great George Street. The Centre is adjacent to the Church steps.

DIRECTIONS BY CAR

1. From the South (M1) and East (M62)

- Continue on the M1
 - Continue onto M621 (for 4.28 miles/6.89 km)
 - Exit onto Slip Road (M621 J2) (for 0.14 miles/0.23 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the third exit onto A643 (for 0.76 miles/ 1.22 km)
 - Continue onto A58 (for 0.24 miles/0.39 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the fourth exit onto Wellington Road (A58) (for 0.48 miles/0.77 km)
 - Continue onto Inner Ring Road (A58(M)) (for 0.24 miles/0.39 km)
 - Exit onto West Street (for 0.14 miles/0.23 km)
 - Bear right onto Park Lane (A58) (for 0.11 miles/0.18 km)
 - Continue along Westgate
 - At the traffic lights turn left onto Oxford Place (for 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Turn left onto Great George Street (for 0.02 miles/0.03 km)
 - Arrive at your destination

2. From the West (M62) (eg Manchester)

- Continue on the M62
 - Bear left onto Slip Road (M62 J27) (for 0.86 miles (1.38 km)
 - Continue onto M621 (for 3.54 miles (5.70 km)
 - Exit onto Slip Road (M621 J2) (for 0.15 miles (0.24 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the first exit onto A643 (for 0.62 miles (1.00 km)
 - Continue onto A58 (for 0.24 miles (0.39 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the fourth exit onto Wellington Road (A58) (for 0.48 miles (0.77 km)
 - Continue onto Inner Ring Road (A58(M)) (for 0.24 miles (0.39 km)
 - Exit onto West Street (for 0.14 miles (0.23 km)
 - Bear right onto Park Lane (A58) (for 0.11 miles (0.18 km)
 - Continue along Westgate
 - At the traffic lights turn left onto Oxford Place (for 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Turn left onto Great George Street (for 0.02 miles/0.03 km)
-

3. From the North West (eg Skipton)

- Continue on the A65
 - At the roundabout, take the first exit onto A660 (For 1.54 miles/2.48 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the second exit onto A660 (For 1 miles/1.61 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the second exit onto Leeds Road (A660) (For 3.84 miles/6.18 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the second exit onto Leeds Road (A660) (For 2.91 miles/4.69 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the second exit onto Otley Road (A660) (For 0.3 miles/0.48 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Otley Road (A660) (For 1.93 miles/3.11 km)
 - Bear right onto Woodhouse Lane (A660) (For 0.56 miles/0.90 km)
 - Bear left onto Blenheim Walk (A660) (For 0.43 miles/0.69 km)
 - Bear right onto Portland Way (A660) (For 0.15 miles/0.24 km)
 - Turn left onto Calverley Street (For 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Turn right onto Portland Street (For 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Continue onto Great George Street (For 0.09 miles/0.14 km)

4. From the North East (A1)

- At Wetherby leave A1, continue onto A58
 - At the roundabout, continue across the Leeds Outer Ring Road (A6120), take the second exit onto Wetherby Road (A58) (For 1.55 miles/2.50 km)
 - At the roundabout, take the second exit onto Easterly Road (A58) (For 0.89 miles/ 1.43 km)
 - Bear left onto Roundhay Road (A58) (For 0.79 miles/ 1.27 km)
 - Bear right onto Barrack Road (A58) (For 0.30 miles/0.48 km)
 - Bear left onto Claypit Lane (A58) (For 0.52 miles/0.84 km)
 - Turn right onto Inner Ring Road (For 0.69 miles/ 1.11 km)
 - Exit onto Inner Ring Road (For 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Bear left onto Park Lane (A58) (For 0.01 miles/0.02 km)
 - Continue along Westgate
 - At the traffic lights turn left onto Oxford Place (for 0.09 miles/0.14 km)
 - Turn left onto Great George Street (for 0.02 miles/0.03 km)
 - Turn right onto Great George Street (For 0.02 miles/0.03 km)
 - Arrive at your destination

CAR & BICYCLE PARKING

St George's Centre has a small car park situated to the side of the Centre and parking is restricted to one vehicle for the organiser of an event. Disabled parking is available at the front of the Centre.

Street parking is available in the immediate vicinity, e.g. Great George Street, Thorseby Place and Portland Street. Monday to Saturday (8.00am to 6.00pm) this currently operates on a 'Pay & Display' ticket basis, with a maximum stay of 2 hours and no return within 1 hour.

Some free parking is available in Hanover Way and Clarendon Road areas on the opposite side of the Inner Ring Road to St George's. Also, there may be some car parking at Joseph's Well. These locations are only a few hundred yards away and the Church can be reached by a foot bridge which spans the Ring Road.

There is also parking at The Light, St John's Centre and Merrion Centre which is about a 10 minute walk from the St George's Centre at the top of Great George Street and is well sign posted.

There is parking for 12 bicycles at the rear of the Church Centre Car Park. Bicycles are not allowed in the Centre itself.

WALKING FROM LEEDS CITY TRAIN STATION (10-15 MINUTES)

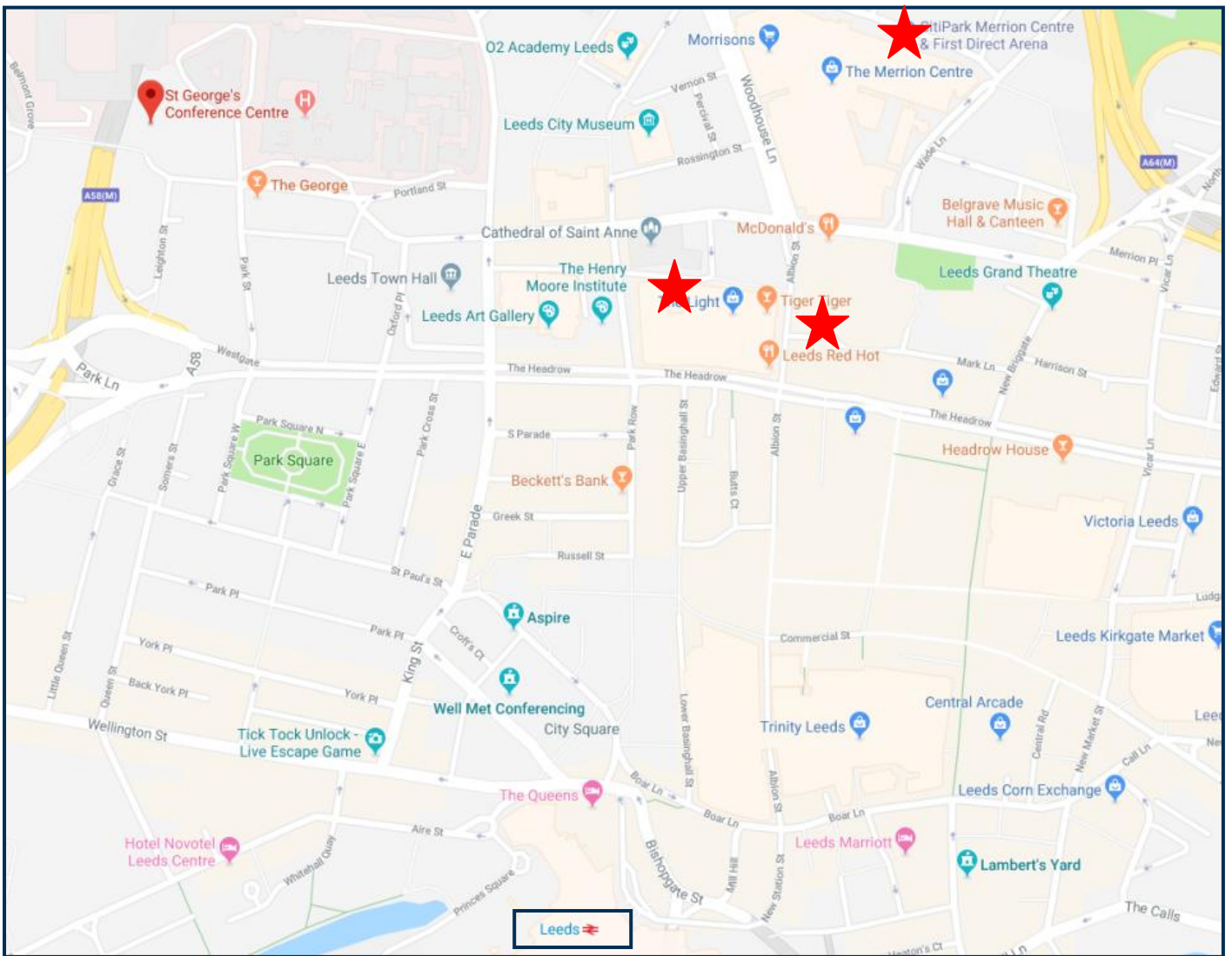
Exit the station from the entrance by the taxi rank. Cross Queens Square into Park Row. Walk up Park Row to the junction with the Headrow. Turn left and cross to the other side of the road at some point. Pass the Art Gallery and Town Hall (lion statues on both ends of it) and turn right into Oxford Place. Walk to the top of the road and turn left into Great George Street. Cross the road - the General Infirmary is on your right. Keep walking right down to the end of Great George Street and turn right into the premises. (Facing Firehouse Fitness Health Club adjacent to the Church Steps).


Please enter through the green pedestrian gate to the left of the church steps. The Reception silver double doors is opposite.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

There is a free city centre circular bus outside the front of the Leeds City Train Station which can drop delegates at Park Lane College. Please cross the road towards little woodhouse and pass the Swamorthmore Centre on your right. Cross the footbridge towards the Church and St George's Centre is on the left adjacent to the church steps.

A taxi from the Leeds City Train Station to St George's Centre is approximately £5.00.



 Multi-storey Pay and Display car parks all located within 5-8 minute walk of St George's Centre.
